

# WORKING TOWARD PROVIDING RESPONSIBLY SOURCED ENERGY

As one of the largest energy infrastructure companies in North America, we recognize that the consumption of energy is a contributor to greenhouse gas emissions. We are actively making enhancements to our business practices and operations to reduce our emissions footprint.

Access to reliable, affordable energy is a critical requirement for improving lives around the world. We are committed to providing energy transportation and storage services in a safe, efficient, and **environmentally responsible manner** for the benefit of people, communities and businesses we serve. We are proud to be part of the effort to **reduce greenhouse gas emissions** by working toward delivering products like **responsibly sourced natural gas**.

## WHAT IS RESPONSIBLY SOURCED NATURAL GAS?

- **Responsibly sourced natural gas** is conventional natural gas that has been produced by companies whose operations have been independently verified as meeting certain environmental, social and governance (ESG) standards including primarily air emission reductions.
- Other factors considered are the company's management practices regarding **water usage**, **community relations efforts** and **chemical management**.

## KINDER MORGAN CONNECTION

The **ONE Future Coalition** has 10 members that have already committed to produce **responsibly sourced natural gas**. This natural gas will need to be safely and responsibly transported. As member of the **ONE Future Coalition**, Kinder Morgan also agreed to reduce our methane emissions to less than 0.31% to achieve a rate of less than 1% across the entire natural gas value chain by 2025. From 2017 through 2019, we have achieved this target with a methane emissions intensity rate for our natural gas transmission and storage assets of **0.04%**, **0.02%** and **0.03%**, respectively.

## WHAT WE ARE DOING

While **responsibly sourced natural gas** is still a developing market, One Future Coalition members produced enough of it to account for **more than 10%** of the current U.S. natural gas production in 2019. We expect this to continue to grow as domestic utilities and international markets look for ways to provide **responsibly sourced energy** to consumers. We are actively engaging our customers, particularly utility companies, to leverage and connect with **responsibly sourced natural gas** producers within our robust pipeline network. As one of the largest transporters of U.S. natural gas with a broad network of pipeline and storage assets in key market centers, we believe we are uniquely positioned to deliver **responsibly sourced natural gas** to the market.

We believe that we can make an impact by **delivering responsibly sourced natural gas** on our systems that already transport approximately **40%** of the natural gas consumed and exported in the **United States everyday**.**
